Dear Parents/Carers

At Rush Common School we have all been saddened by the death of Queen Elizabeth II. The children this week have all been engaging in activities to understand her incredible life, and tireless service to our country over the last 70 years. We hope children have been sharing some of their learning and work with you at home. As the longest serving monarch in British history, she will be missed by so many, who understood her inspirational devotion and sense of duty to our nation.

It has been a great start to the year for our pupils, with the school buzzing with learning. Children in all year groups have been highly enagaged as they start life in their new classrooms. At this point in the year, we always have a large number of new children joining our school, and they have all settled into Rush Common life really well. It has been lovely to welcome all the new families, and we hope you feel at home as much as the children do!

Thank you for coming to the 'Meet the Teachers' meetings this week. The meetings were well attended, and we hope they were useful in finding out about the year ahead. I would like to update you on the current situation with regards to tree planting at Rush Common. Unfortunately, during the last academic year, we had to considerably scale back the tree planting that had taken place, due to a number of practical factors relating to site management. Then, over the summer the unprecedented heatwaves meant that a number of the saplings did not survive. As we had received our tree packs from the Woodland Trust, we would like to make a donation to this charity from our school. To this end, we will be holding a non-school uniform fundraising day on Friday 4th November, which will also serve to raise the profile of the Trust's Net Zero Carbon commitment. The Woodland Trust is a fantastic charity responsible for planting trees, saving woods and bringing ancient woodlands back to life. You will receive a further email about the fundraising day in due course.

Over the course of this term, many prospective new parents will be attending our taster sessions, open days and school tours. All of the details of these visits are included further in this newsletter. Please can I ask you to spread the word to any families that may be interested, and tell them about everything our school can offer. Your help with this is vital in ensuring as many parents as possible visit the school, and ultimately increase the number of children attending our fabulous school!

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


